

FROM THE PASTOR

In this Sunday's Gospel, the Lord Jesus commands His disciples to "put out into the deep," so that they might haul in a great and unexpected catch of fish. This miracle is, of course, revelatory of Christ's plan of training us to invest boldly and creatively in plumbing the depths of our Catholic faith. There is ultimately no value in merely skimming the surface of God's promises.

With only a week and a half before the beginning of Lent on Ash Wednesday (February 17), we as a Parish need to make the necessary preparations to explore the depths of the spiritual life and its promised transformations, like the fishermen-Apostles first did.

As I announced in January, our upcoming Parish Mission provides just this opportunity of spiritual renewal for us. Entitled "Falling in Love Again," the Parish Mission from Sunday, March 7 to Thursday, March 11 is focused on rekindling and deepening the central passions in our life of faith---passions for friendship, for truth, for family, for forgiveness, and ultimately for a better, fuller life.

Think of the Parish Mission week as a mini-retreat, the details of which are on the bulletin insert page for easy posting on the home fridge. **These evenings are designed for the whole family, and it is my fervent hope and prayer that everyone in our Parish (and anyone at all who would benefit from an invitation to---or back to---Queen of Peace) will join us throughout this week.** You know when the Pastor goes both bold and underlined that I am serious!!! Consider this week the first of your happy Lenten resolutions.

In addition, I shall be offering a Lenten Book Club on four Wednesdays of Lent at 7PM (Feb 24 & Mar 3; Mar 17 & 24)---the two before and the two after the Parish Mission. Our featured book is Peter Kreeft's *Before I Go: Letters To Our Children About What Really Matters*.

Peter Kreeft is a philosophy professor, a convert to Catholicism, and one of the most popular teachers in the history of Boston College. *Before I Go* is both profound and easy to read; the book is divided into 162 meditations of one or two pages each. Copies will be available beginning this Wednesday in the Parish Office for the discounted price of \$13 each.

Our last Faith in Film Fest presentation (before resuming again during Eastertide, in mid-April) is this Wednesday, Feb. 10 at 6PM in the gym. The recent Disney adaptation of C. S. Lewis' classic, *The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe* will be our feature. Childcare is available by contacting the Parish Office earlier in the week.

Fill your calendar, plumb the depths, and full speed into Lent---we're in it for Easter.

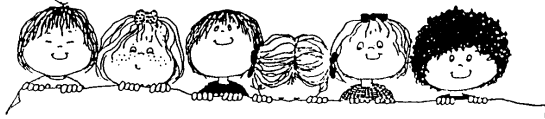

A BREATH OF FRESH AIR FOR YOUR MARRIAGE -



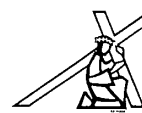
