**Athletic Progress Reports:** Progress reports for student-athletes were conducted this afternoon. All student-athletes were examined to ensure they were meeting our eligibility requirements. Student-athletes who did not meet the eligibility requirements, as outlined in our parent handbook, were placed on a two-week probationary period.
