Reading: Different Genres

We will be focusing on different genres of literature including fairy tales and tall tales.

Writing: Simple 6/Unit 2

We will complete our work on the Simple 6 techniques focusing on Different Sentence Patterns & Descriptive Sentences. We also will be working on prompt attack in preparation for the I-STEP. Finally, we will focus on Unit 2: Nouns.

Math: Unit 6 Geometry

Science: The Moon and Earth
